The Arlington Historical Society, originally called the Cemetery Society, was founded August 27, 1887, to promote, develop and support the process of collecting and preserving documents, pictures, and historical information pertaining to the founding and growth of Arlington.

Today the Society remains dedicated to the preservation of local history while serving as caretaker of the Historic Fielder House, the Fielder Museum, the Historic Cemeteries on Arkansas Lane, and the Knapp Heritage Park.

Knapp Heritage Park 201 W. Front Street

Dedicated in 2004, this downtown park is home to some of Arlington's oldest The Jopling-Melear and structures: Watson Family cabins, constructed in the mid-1800's; the 1910 North Side one-room schoolhouse; and the law office of James Knapp, for whom the park is named. Knapp Heritage Park is open Saturday and Sunday 1-4 pm. The relocation of the Bardin Family Barn and its reconstruction as a Blacksmith Shop at Knapp Heritage Park was completed in 2010. James Ryan, resident Artisan/Blacksmith, is on hand the last Sunday of each month to show off his talent and accept special orders. Weekend venues may include live demonstrations/events, e.g. corn husk doll workshop, local musician and/or oral history recitation. Sunday the park is open for tours.












Historic Fielder House



The Historic Fielder House, located at the corner of Fielder and Abram Streets, was built for Mr. and Mrs. James Park Fielder, Sr. as their private residence in 1914. The two-story house surrounded by magnificent oaks was one of the first brick homes in Arlington. The galleries at the Fielder House are primarily used to exhibit themes and topics relating to the history of Arlington and its surrounding communities.



- 1980's Present: Fielder Museum






